### 6. Public Input:

#### **Questions and Answers**

Programs - do they consult with special ed?

Amy R. answered - There is usually a committee. "We try to have a representation of all areas, ELL, Special Ed, Administrators with recommendations made."

Budget related - district is adding a position for Autism program

Amy R. - Team Chair position added. Amy spoke about the new position. Q/A discussion included, Patti Doherty is retiring.

Further Questions/Answers and discussion included:

- Q. Are parents allowed to be on some of those committees -
- A. We do involve parents posting is up. We will look at a screening/bring in for interviews. Will establish a committee tap into parents who have students in those programs or level. Good question
- Q. That would be published? Disseminated?
- A. Probably not through a connect ed but an outreach.

Discussion: For new position - Those children staying in. Q. regarding: New children, would Team Chair change? A. We haven't thought about that yet, don't anticipate that - determined on a case by case basis. Ali, regarding Patti Doherty's position: SEPAC would be a resource to be on the Finding Committee.

Ali at this point states: Floor is still open.

Parent comment about Transition Piece - wondering is that happening across the district? Discussion involved: Needs looking at, a lot of work from Renee Morgan at HS. PreK - K hardest transition. Transitioning happening at other levels. Happening 4th grade meeting with 5th grade to have transition discussions. Tailored toward what that looks like based on individualized needs. On a separate day, spend time to see what building looks like...Critical help make things be successful. Strengthen that. Talk about Communication (all discussion points).

- Q. Transition meeting will there be Parker Staff at meeting (from Elementary)? It does happen for many students...
- A. Yes, that absolutely would occur If necessary, schedule a separate transition meeting...parents can always contact Special Ed to make that happen. Discussion ends.

# 7. Parent Support Group:

Jen B and Laurie M continue to run an online facebook group to help bring Topics of Interest, Concern, News and Updates to the Chelmsford SEPAC. In person meetings were held 1-2 times every/every other month both a.m. and p.m. Volunteers are needed to help continue in person meetings.
